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Mark J. Eanes, M.D., M.B.A.



Dr. Mark Eanes is a board-certified ophthalmologist who has practiced in Valdosta, GA for 37 years. In addition to being on staff at South Georgia Medical Center, other past **medical affiliations** include the clinical faculty at Medical College of Georgia, Veterans Administration Hospital; and credentialed to practice medicine by the Peruvian Ministry of Defense.

He received his undergraduate degree in biology from Valdosta State University. His **medical degree, medical internship and ophthalmology residency** were completed at Medical College of Georgia, Augusta, and his **MBA for Physician Executives** at Kennesaw State University in Kennesaw, Georgia.

He has served in many **leadership roles locally**, including Lowndes County Board of Health since 1993, chairman since 1994. As an active staff member of South Georgia Medical Center since 1986, he has served on many committees and held several positions, including Chairman of the Executive Committee and Chief of Staff. He has been involved in community organizations such as Leadership Lowndes, Boy Scouts of America, YMCA sports programs; and he has been a member of two school boards. He has also served as President of the VSU Alumni Association. Dr. Eanes has been involved in local not-for-profit organizations, including serving on the boards of The Mailbox Club and Options Now (crisis pregnancy center) where he has twice served as President of the Board of Directors.

Leadership on a state level includes many positions in the Georgia Society of Ophthalmology, serving as president in 1996-97. He has been on the Board of Directors of the Medical Association of Georgia, including the MAG Council of Legislation. He is currently on the Board of Managers and Finance Committee of Live Oak Accountable Care Organization (ACO) and has held key positions in the South Georgia Physician Network. He chaired the Board of Directors and served as interim CEO of South Georgia Health Partners (MCO) and has been involved in the South Georgia Medical Society, Georgia Health Decisions, Medical Resource Network, South Georgia Physician/Hospital Organization and Georgia Society to Prevent Blindness.

Because of his **compassion for the poor and impoverished populations**, Dr. Eanes established Heaven In Sight Missions in 2006, which has provided humanitarian relief in at least 16 developing countries around the world, serving in many of these countries multiple times. Heaven In Sight occasionally partners with other nation-wide organizations to further impact the under-served.

Dr. Eanes now considers the opportunity to help the under-served population locally a privilege, and he is looking forward to the contribution he can make to improve the overall health of Georgians, building upon the tremendous foundations of the passionate staff and leadership of South Health District.

The Berrien County Board of Health met by conference call Tuesday, January 10, 2023.

Call to Order

- Dr. Nash called the meeting to order at 12:33 p.m.

Public Comments

- There were no public comments.

Approval of October 12, 2022 Minutes

- Mr. Barkman made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 12, 2022 meeting as presented. Mr. Clayton seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

New Business:

Financial Information – Allie Pridgen (See attachments)

- Mss. Pridgen presented the Berrien County Health Department’s current Revenue and Expense Summary from October – current, noting the budget was increased by \$11,361. This amount was provided by the state to fund nursing increases.
- Adjustments were made to salaries, hourly labor, FICA, and health insurance to reflect budget changes.
- Approximately 48.9% of the budget has been spent and the health department is on track.

Public Health Updates – William R. Grow, MD, FACP (See attachments)

- Dr. Grow informed the Board cases of flu, RSV as well as COVID are currently being seen at this time.
- COVID hospitalizations are still at a low rate although there are some counties in the district, with high transmission rates.
- Statewide COVID cases have increased by 30%, which is significantly higher than district cases over the last two months. Not all cases are being reported due to the ability to test at home.
- COVID omicron variants are easily transmissible; however, immunity from vaccination is still effective.
- Berrien is one of the 63 counties considered to have medium transmission levels at this time.

- Dr. Grow provide additional COVID updates including the statewide average of approximately 6,000 reinfections with hospitalizations and deaths reported in those who are under or unvaccinated.
- Dr. Nash added he is seeing some flu and COVID, but it is not overwhelming as it has been. Most patients are being treated as outpatient with a few hospitalizations.

Health Department Update – Dawn Bowen (Attachment)

- Ms. Bowen provided Berrien County Health Department updates since the October 2022 meeting.
- Berrien staff administered 489 flu and 123 COVID vaccinations since September.
- COVID test kits are still available at no charge and may be picked up at the front desk at the health department.
- Approximately one-two COVID tests per month are being administered.
- Berrien has been approved for the car seat mini grant for 2023. The first class is scheduled for January 11, 2023. This is a six-hour training which includes having the participants install the car seat correctly in their vehicles.
- Two registered nurses will be trained to insert Nexplanon implants, which are long-acting contraceptives. This is a pilot program with training beginning next week for one of the nurses.

Environmental Health Update (Lee Meeks) Attachment

- Mr. Meeks provided the most current environmental health update for Berrien, which included activities and inspection reports for October 11, 2022 – January 9, 2023, which included food service scores.
- A decline in land use toward the end of the year was noted. Mr. Meeks added he has seen the same decline in both counties he visits.
- Berrien issued 105 septic permits in 2022, which is an increase of 29 permits from the previous calendar year (2021).

- The remaining 2023 board of health meeting dates are listed on the agenda.

Adjournment

- There being no further business, Ms. Nix made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clayton. All were in favor and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 12:45 p.m.

Mission: To implement a sustainable, collaborative, and multi-disciplinary approach in response to Georgia’s opioid and substance misuse crisis.

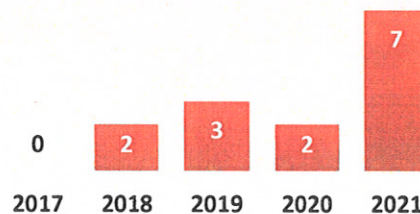
Vision: To improve access to state and local data; to recommend and/or implement education best practices; and to promote the use of law enforcement, healthcare, and public health resources to prevent the misuse of opioids and other substances in Georgia.

Opioid-Related Overdose Deaths

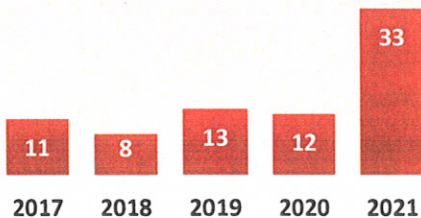
Between 2017 – 2021, there were a total of 14 opioid-related overdose deaths for Berrien county.

- 100% White American
- 42.9% Male
- 57.1% Female

Opioid-Related Overdose ER Visits

Between 2017 – 2021, there were a total of 77 opioid-related overdose ER visits for Berrien county.

- 97.4% White American
- 2.6% African American
- 41.6% Male
- 58.4% Female



Public Health Emergency

June 2017 – First public health response to overdose cluster in Macon, GA due to fake Percocets laced with U-47700 and cyclopropyl fentanyl.

October 2017 – Former President Trump and Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) declare opioid crisis a public health emergency.



Surveillance Activities

Syndromic Surveillance – Detection system reporting to DPH via hospitals based on patient’s chief complaint and/or discharge diagnosis.

Vital Records and hospital reporting via DPH.

ODMAP – Application for law enforcement and first responders to report suspected overdose data across jurisdictions in near real time to support public safety and public health efforts in hopes to mobilize an immediate response to a sudden increase, or spikes in overdose events. The use of ODMAP by partnering agencies will bridge gaps in data collection.



Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

The Georgia Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) is an electronic database used to monitor the prescribing and dispensing of controlled substances. The PDMP provides prescribers and pharmacists with critical information regarding a patient’s controlled substance prescription history. It can help eliminate duplicative prescribing and overprescribing of controlled substances and protect patients at risk of misuse.



Naloxone Standing Order

Issued by DPH Commissioner Kathleen Toomey. Naloxone is available for all residents of the state of Georgia to ensure that family members, friends, co-workers, first responders, schools, harm reduction organizations, and others are able to provide assistance to a person experiencing an opioid-related overdose.



GA 911 Medical Amnesty Law

Any person who in good faith seeks medical assistance for a person experiencing or believed to be experiencing a drug overdose shall not be arrested, charged, or prosecuted for a drug violation if the evidence for the arrest, charge, or prosecution of such drug violation resulted solely from seeking medical assistance. Any person who is experiencing a drug overdose and, in good faith, seeks medical assistance for himself/herself or is the subject of such a request shall not be arrested, charged, or prosecuted for a drug violation if the evidence for the arrest, charge, or prosecution of such drug violation resulted solely from seeking such medical assistance.
